SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$500,000 from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to Treatment Alternatives for Stronger Communities to support its pursuit of certification as a Comprehensive Community Mental Health Center. Effective July 1, 2026.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much of that amount
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
6 Fund to the Department of Human Services for a grant to
7 Treatment Alternatives for Stronger Communities to support its
8 pursuit of certification as a Comprehensive Community Mental
9 Health Center beginning with the TASC offices in Rockford and
10 Peoria. The grant shall support a one-year implementation
11 period with allowable expenses including, but not limited to,
12 cloud-based information technology services; expert
13 consultation; staffing including, management and supervisory
14 staff; and the provision of direct service to clients.

15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
16 2026.
