1 HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, Architecture shapes the character and identity of
3 public spaces, uplifting communities, reflecting shared
4 values, and inspiring pride in government institutions; and

5 WHEREAS, Public buildings funded by the State of Illinois
6 should be clearly recognizable as civic structures, designed
7 to honor Illinois' rich history, culture, and architectural
8 heritage; and

9 WHEREAS, Traditional, classical, and other historically
10 rooted architectural styles have long enhanced public spaces,
11 strengthened community identity, and upheld the ideals of
12 democracy; and

13 WHEREAS, The public has a vested interest in civic
14 architecture, and incorporating community input ensures that
15 designs reflect the aspirations of Illinois residents;
16 therefore, be it

17 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
18 HUNDRED FOURTH GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
19 we urge the Administrator of the Capital Development Board, in
20 consultation with the Office of the Governor and other
21 relevant state agencies, to develop recommendations promoting

1 civic buildings that are visually identifiable and respectful
2 of Illinois' regional, traditional, and classical
3 architectural heritage; and be it further

4 RESOLVED, That these recommendations should propose
5 revisions to architectural guidelines and outline procedures
6 for incorporating public input into design decisions; and be
7 it further

8 RESOLVED, That if, before submitting these
9 recommendations, the Administrator of the Capital Development
10 Board proposes approving a new building design that does not
11 align with this policy, the Administrator should notify the
12 Governor at least 30 days prior to final approval and provide a
13 justification for the design; and be it further

14 RESOLVED, That suitable copies of this resolution be
15 delivered to the Administrator of the Capital Development
16 Board and the Office of the Governor.
