of Illinois 2 WHEREAS, The members the House of 3 Representatives wish to recognize Chief John W. Stenson, the 4 first and only African American Chief of Police for the Peoria 5 Police Department, on his years of service to his community; 6 and

WHEREAS, Chief Stenson began working as a patrol officer with the Peoria Police Department in 1966; he was promoted to detective in 1971, sergeant in 1973, lieutenant in 1977, captain in 1983, assistant chief of police in March 1997, and chief of police in October 1997; he retired from the Peoria Police Department in April 2004; and

WHEREAS, Chief Stenson received an associate's degree in police science from Illinois Central College in 1972 and a bachelor's degree in police administration from Bradley University in 1974; he later worked toward a master's degree at Sangamon State University, and he continued to attend education seminars and classes through courses at a number of institutions, including the University of Illinois, the Northwest Police Institute, the FBI Academy in Quantico, and the Kennedy School of Government; and

WHEREAS, Chief Stenson has been a contributing member in a

- 2 Illinois Association of Law Enforcement Executives, the FBI
- 3 Alumni Association, the Illinois Association of Chiefs of
- 4 Police, the International Association of Chiefs of Police, the
- 5 National Organization for Black Law Enforcement Executives,
- 6 the Peoria County Association of Chiefs of Police, and the
- 7 Police Executive Research Forum; and
- 8 WHEREAS, Chief Stenson has completed a great deal of 9 community service throughout his working career and his 10 retirement within a variety of organizations, including the 11 Carver Community Center, the Counseling and Family Services 12 Board, the Crittenton Care and Counseling Center, the Cultural Diversity Committee, the Emergency Telephone System Boar, the 1.3 14 Eureka college Board of Trustees, the Family violence 15 Coordinating Council, the Multi-county Narcotics Enforcement 16 Group Board, the Peoria Empowerment Committee, the American Red Cross, the DARE Organization, the Heart of Illinois United 17 Way Board, the Jail Population Task Force, the Peoria Boys 18 19 Club, the Peoria Alternative Charter School Board, the Peoria Area Community Events Board, the Peoria Housing Authority, the 20 21 Peoria Public Schools Facility Analysis Committee, Planned 22 Parenthood, the Tri-County Urban League, and many more; and
