3 Representatives are saddened to learn of the death of Tyrone
4 Haymore of Robbins; and

5 WHEREAS, Tyrone Haymore earned degrees from Northeastern
6 Illinois University and Thornton Junior College, and he was a
7 scholar of African American culture, history, and political
8 science; and

9 WHEREAS, Tyrone Haymore served as executive director,
10 curator, and historian of the Robbins Historical Society,
11 preserving the history of Robbins with unmatched dedication,
12 passion, and purpose for over 26 years; his leadership led to
13 the opening of the Robbins History Museum on August 28, 2010, a
14 milestone achievement that gave voice to a village rich in
15 African American excellence and cultural contributions; and

16 WHEREAS, Tyrone Haymore was also a devoted public servant,
17 having served as a village clerk and trustee of the Village of
18 Robbins for nearly three decades; and

19 WHEREAS, Tyrone Haymore was a beloved community pillar,
20 educator, and advocate known for his deep knowledge,
21 unwavering pride in Robbins, and commitment to telling the

2 WHEREAS, Tyrone Haymore will be remembered for his
3 dedication and commitment to preserving the histories and the
4 stories of the people of Robbins; therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
