8 20 transformative years as its executive director, leading the
9 organization with passion, vision, and unwavering commitment;

WHEREAS, Under Margaret Frisbie's leadership, Friends of the Chicago River's mission to protect and restore the Chicago-Calumet River system for all people, water, and wildlife has flourished, resulting in cleaner water, an increase in thriving wildlife habitats, and greater public engagement throughout the region; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie, since assuming the role of executive director in 2005, has become a leading voice for the implementation of multi-beneficial natural solutions that build climate resiliency, protect biodiversity, and improve public health in an urban landscape; and

1 WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie has pioneered signature 2 initiatives that have reshaped the Chicago-Calumet River system, including the launch of the award-winning Natural 3 Solutions Tool, the establishment of the Greater Chicago 4 Watershed Alliance, and the creation of instream habitat 5 restoration projects, including the Michigan Avenue Fish 6 7 Hotel, which is the first floating habitat in the system; and

WHEREAS, Under Margaret Frisbie's visionary direction, Friends of the Chicago River has garnered 45 awards and honors in 25 years, and the Chicago-Calumet River system is now widely recognized as a vibrant urban ecosystem that is clean, healthy, biodiverse, resilient, and welcoming; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie's leadership in policy and planning has led to the development of enforceable water quality standards that protect aquatic life and swimmers, the creation of Overflow Action Days, and the establishment of Chicago's River Ecology and Governance Task Force; and

WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie's commitment to wildlife conservation has been evident in many Friends of the Chicago River projects, including supporting nesting turtles, osprey, bats, and channel catfish and the restoration of thousands of acres of upland and riparian habitat; and

- 2 public engagement programs, including the McCormick
- 3 Bridgehouse & Chicago River Museum, which welcomes over 38,000
- 4 visitors annually, and the comprehensive Litter Free

- 6 WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie has been internationally
- 7 recognized for her work, including being named a River
- 8 Champion by River Network in 2017 and a Notable Leader in
- 9 Sustainability by Crain's Chicago Business in 2022; and
- 10 WHEREAS, Margaret Frisbie has left an indelible mark on
- 11 the Chicago-Calumet River system, transforming it along Lake
- 12 Forest, Lemont, Summit, Sauk Village, and everywhere in
- 13 between, while inspiring generations to value and protect the
- 14 waterway that runs through the heart of the region; therefore,
