1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 415

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend Senate Bill 415, AS AMENDED,  
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment  
4 No. 1, on page 2, by replacing line 19 with the following:

5 "for legitimate instructional purposes, as determined by the  
6 school district. Within the context of the legitimate  
7 instructional purposes, the use of biometric information shall  
8 be solely for identification or fraud prevention. Biometric  
9 systems incorporated into school-issued electronic devices for  
10 identification or fraud prevention constitute a legitimate  
11 instructional purpose under this Section.

12 The provisions of subsection (a-5) and this subsection  
13 (a-10) regarding the use of biometric information for purposes  
14 other than legitimate instructional purposes shall not affect  
15 any existing contractual obligation under a contract entered  
16 into before January 1, 2027 between a school district and any  
17 entity for the purpose of obtaining, collecting, processing,  
18 storing, transmitting, displaying, or otherwise handling

1 biometric information, as long as the contract is not extended  
2 or rolled over if the contract may be extended or rolled over.  
3 A school district that has entered into a contract with an  
4 entity for the purpose of obtaining, collecting, processing,  
5 storing, transmitting, displaying, or otherwise handling  
6 biometric information before January 1, 2027 shall provide a  
7 written notice, by the 2027-2028 school year, to the  
8 individual having legal custody of the student or to the  
9 student if he or she has reached the age of 18 of the existing  
10 option to discontinue the use of the student's biometric  
11 information under subparagraph (B) of paragraph (2) of  
12 subsection (b). Any provision of a contract between an entity  
13 and a school district for the purpose of obtaining,  
14 collecting, processing, storing, transmitting, displaying, or  
15 otherwise handling biometric information entered into on or  
16 after January 1, 2027 that conflicts with this Section is  
17 void."; and

18 on page 3, line 15, by replacing "The" with "Within the context  
19 of the legitimate instructional purposes, the ~~The~~"; and

20 on page 5, by replacing line 21 with the following:

21 "for legitimate instructional purposes, as determined by the  
22 school district. Within the context of the legitimate  
23 instructional purposes, the use of biometric information shall  
24 be solely for identification or fraud prevention. Biometric

1 systems incorporated into school-issued electronic devices for  
2 identification or fraud prevention constitute a legitimate  
3 instructional purpose under this Section.

4 The provisions of subsection (a-5) and this subsection  
5 (a-10) regarding the use of biometric information for purposes  
6 other than legitimate instructional purposes shall not affect  
7 any existing contractual obligation under a contract entered  
8 into before January 1, 2027 between a school district and any  
9 entity for the purpose of obtaining, collecting, processing,  
10 storing, transmitting, displaying, or otherwise handling  
11 biometric information, as long as the contract is not extended  
12 or rolled over if the contract may be extended or rolled over.  
13 A school district that has entered into a contract with an  
14 entity for the purpose of obtaining, collecting, processing,  
15 storing, transmitting, displaying, or otherwise handling  
16 biometric information before January 1, 2027 shall provide a  
17 written notice, by the 2027-2028 school year, to the  
18 individual having legal custody of the student or to the  
19 student if he or she has reached the age of 18 of the existing  
20 option to discontinue the use of the student's biometric  
21 information under subparagraph (B) of paragraph (2) of

23 and a school district for the purpose of obtaining,  
24 collecting, processing, storing, transmitting, displaying, or  
25 otherwise handling biometric information entered into on or  
26 after January 1, 2027 that conflicts with this Section is
