1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 635

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 635, AS AMENDED,
3 with reference to page and line numbers of Senate Amendment
4 No. 2, by replacing line 21 on page 11 through line 6 on page
5 12 with the following:

6 "(e) Nothing in this Act exempts developments affecting
7 locally designated landmarks or properties within locally
8 designated historic districts from review under an adopted
9 historic preservation ordinance if the ordinance has clear and
10 objective standards and is applied in a generally uniform and
11 nondiscriminatory manner. After submission of a complete
12 application, review by a historic preservation commission or a
13 similar body applying clear and objective standards must occur
14 at the next regularly scheduled meeting, and a decision shall
15 be rendered within 30 days of the meeting. Review by a historic
16 preservation commission or similar body applying clear and
17 objective standards shall not be considered a prohibited
18 discretionary approval under this Act."
