SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 5/5-735 new

Amends the Civil Administrative Code of Illinois. Provides that all State agencies shall waive any fees assessed to a formerly incarcerated person for services provided by that State agency for a period of one year after the release of that person from a facility operated by the Department of Corrections, the Department of Juvenile Justice, or the Federal Bureau of Prisons.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Civil Administrative Code of Illinois is
5 amended by adding Section 5-735 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 5/5-735 new)

7 Sec. 5-735. Fee waiver for formally incarcerated
8 individuals. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, all
9 State agencies shall waive any fees assessed to a formerly
10 incarcerated person for services provided by that State agency
11 for a period of one year after the release of that person from
12 a facility operated by the Department of Corrections, the
13 Department of Juvenile Justice, or the Federal Bureau of
14 Prisons.
