1 <u>Sec. 25-115. Home rule.</u>

- (a) The regulation and licensing of sports wagering, including, but not limited to, the imposition of fees, surcharges, or other costs for the privilege of conducting or participating in sports wagering, are exclusive powers and functions of the State. A home rule unit may not regulate or license sports wagering. This subsection (a) is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and functions under subsection (h) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.
- (b) A home rule unit may not impose or collect a tax on sports wagering or a tax on receipts generated from sports wagering. This subsection (b) is a denial and limitation of home rule powers and functions under subsection (g) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution.".
