SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 575/4.1 new

Amends the Business Enterprise for Minorities, Women, and Persons with Disabilities Act. Provides that certifications granted under the Act on or after the effective date of the amendatory Act shall be active for a minimum of 5 years. Provides that certified vendors shall inform the Program of any changes in the vendor's business status or ownership that may impact the vendor's certification status. Provides that Program staff shall inform the vendor no later than 6 months before the vendor's certification expires.

4 Section 5. The Business Enterprise for Minorities, Women,
5 and Persons with Disabilities Act is amended by adding Section
6 4.1 as follows:

8 Sec. 4.1. Term of certification. Certifications granted
9 under this Act on or after the effective date of this
10 amendatory Act of the 104th General Assembly shall be active
11 for a minimum of 5 years. Certified vendors shall inform the
12 Program of any changes in the vendor's business status or
13 ownership that may impact the vendor's certification status.
14 Program staff shall inform the vendor at least 6 months before
15 the vendor's certification expires.
