### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 708/31 new

Amends the Grant Accountability and Transparency Act. Provides that the Governor's Office of Management and Budget shall compile an annual budget implementation report. Provides that the report shall include the following information concerning each grant agreement entered into by a State awarding agency during the previous calendar year: (1) the total cost of each project; (2) detailed line items specified under guidelines issued by the Governor's Office of Management and Budget; and (3) a description specified purpose for the project. Requires the report to be submitted to the General Assembly and posted on the website of the Governor's Office of Management and Budget. Effective immediately.

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Grant Accountability and Transparency Act  
5 is amended by adding Section 31 as follows:

6 (30 ILCS 708/31 new)

7 Sec. 31. Budget implementation report. By January 1, 2026,  
8 and by January 1 of each year thereafter, the Governor's  
9 Office of Management and Budget shall compile a budget  
10 implementation report. The budget implementation report shall  
11 include the following information concerning each grant  
12 agreement entered into by a State grant-making agency during  
13 the previous calendar year:

14 (1) the total cost of each project;

15 (2) detailed line items specified under guidelines  
16 issued by the Governor's Office of Management and Budget;  
17 and

18 (3) a description of the specified purpose for the  
19 project.

20 The report shall be submitted to the General Assembly and  
21 shall be posted on the website of the Governor's Office of  
22 Management and Budget.

1           Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon  
2           becoming law.
