Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2025, as follows:

Section 40. The amount of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the IEMA State Projects Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security for the purposes of conducting a Mississippi Water Commission Southwest Illinois Levee Systems Study.

Section 45. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Emergency Planning and Training Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security for costs associated with the Safety and Aid for the Environment in Carbon Capture and Sequestration Act (SAFE CCS).

Section 60. The sum of \$525,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security for licensing facilities where radioactive uranium and thorium mill tailings are generated or located, and related costs for regulating the decontamination and decommissioning of such facilities and for identification, decontamination, and environmental monitoring of unlicensed properties contaminated with such radioactive mill tailings.

Section 65. The sum of \$60,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Radiation Protection

- 19 expenses pursuant to Section 3-660 of the Illinois Vehicle

- Section 145. The amount of \$43,000,000, or so much thereof
- 22 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the IEMA State

3 ARTICLE 2

Section 5. The sum of \$51,816,860 or so much thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of business on June 30, 2025, from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in Article 130, Section 395 of Public Act 103-0589, as amended, is reappropriated from the State Coronavirus Urgent Remediation Emergency Fund to the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security for any costs eligible for payment from Coronavirus State Fiscal Recovery Fund moneys in accordance with the American Rescue Plan Act and related federal guidance, or from any other federal fund pursuant to any other provision of federal law, including but not limited to, costs related to the COVID-19 pandemic response, including purchases of protective personal equipment, state agency health and safety measures, costs associated with care sites, and other emergency response costs, including prior years' costs, current and prior year operational expenses, awards, and grants of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency and Office of Homeland Security and other State agencies for the support of programs and services that assist people and entities impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic and the State's emergency response to the

- 1 pandemic.
- 2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
