8 issue subpoenas to any person, administer an oath or  
9 affirmation to any person, conduct hearings in aid of any  
10 investigation or inquiry, prescribe such forms, require  
11 written answers under oath to written interrogatories, and  
12 promulgate such rules and regulations as may be necessary,  
13 which rules and regulations shall have the force of law. To  
14 accomplish the objectives and to carry out the duties  
15 prescribed by this Act, the State's Attorney of any county may  
16 issue subpoenas to any person.

20 documentary materials that are obtained by the Attorney  
21 General or a State's Attorney under Section 4 of this Act are  
22 exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act.  
23 This exemption shall apply to all information and documentary

1 materials the Attorney General or a State's Attorney obtains  
2 through an investigation under this Act.

3 (1) Except as otherwise provided in this Section, no  
4 documentary materials, transcripts of oral testimony, or  
5 answers to interrogatories, or copies thereof, in the  
6 possession of the Attorney General shall be available for  
7 examination by any individual other than an authorized  
8 employee of the Attorney General or other law enforcement  
9 officials, federal, State, or local, without the consent  
10 of the person who produced the documentary materials,  
11 transcripts, or interrogatory answers. The Attorney  
12 General may provide copies of such documentary material,  
13 answers to written interrogatories, or transcripts of oral  
14 testimony to an official of this State, the federal  
15 government, or another state, who is charged with the  
16 enforcement of federal or state antitrust or consumer  
17 protection laws, if before the disclosure the receiving  
18 official agrees in writing that the information may not be  
19 disclosed to anyone other than the official or the  
20 official's authorized employees.

21 (2) The Attorney General may, in the Attorney  
22 General's discretion, use information and documentary  
23 materials obtained in the course of an investigation  
24 pursuant to this Act for law enforcement purposes,  
25 including, but not limited to, interviewing or questioning  
26 potential witnesses and consultants, in a complaint or

1 other pleading, and in court proceedings."
