**SB2725**

**SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:**

505 ILCS 89/20

Amends the Industrial Hemp Act. Provides that no hemp cannabinoid shall be bottled and sold for purchase in a package or container that contains caffeine, including, but not limited to, ready to drink beverages. Defines "hemp cannabinoid".

A BILL FOR

1           AN ACT concerning agriculture.

2           **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3           **represented in the General Assembly:**

4           Section 5. The Industrial Hemp Act is amended by changing  
5           Section 20 as follows:

6           (505 ILCS 89/20)

7           Sec. 20. Hemp products.

8           (a) Nothing in this Act shall alter the legality of hemp or  
9           hemp products that are presently legal to possess or own.

10           (b) No hemp cannabinoid shall be bottled and sold for  
11           purchase in a package or container that contains caffeine,  
12           including, but not limited to, ready to drink beverages. For  
13           the purposes of this Section, "hemp cannabinoid" means a  
14           naturally occurring phytocannabinoid derived from the hemp  
15           plant that does not have an intoxicating effect on the mind and  
16           body, as determined by the Department by rule, including:

- 17           (1) cannabidiol (CBD);
- 18           (2) cannabichromene (CBC);
- 19           (3) cannabicitran (CBT);
- 20           (4) cannabicyclol (CBL);
- 21           (5) cannabielsoin (CBE);
- 22           (6) cannabigerol (CBG);
- 23           (7) cannabidivarin (CBDV); or

1                   (8) cannabinol (CBN).
