20 Sec. 356z.88. Coverage for seizure detection devices.

21 (a) For the purposes of this Section, "seizure detection  
22 device" means a monitoring device cleared by the United States  
23 Food and Drug Administration, and any related technology,  
24 application, service, or subscription supporting the

1 prescribed use of the device, that provides the following:

2 (1) individual monitoring and alert services relating  
3 to seizure activity;

4 (2) detection or prediction of seizure activity and  
5 transmission of notification of the seizure activity to  
6 the individual or a caregiver for appropriate medical  
7 response; or

8 (3) collection of data of the seizure activity of the  
9 individual that can be used by a health care provider to  
10 diagnose or appropriately treat a health care condition  
11 that causes the seizure activity.

12 (b) A group or individual plan of accident and health  
13 insurance or managed care plan amended, delivered, issued, or  
14 renewed on or after January 1, 2028 shall provide coverage for  
15 medically prescribed seizure detection devices.

16 (c) All seizure detection devices covered under this  
17 Section shall be approved for use by individuals, and the  
18 choice of device shall be made based upon the individual's  
19 circumstances and medical needs in consultation with the  
20 individual's medical provider.

21 (d) Any individual who has been prescribed a seizure  
22 detection device shall not be required to obtain prior  
23 authorization for coverage for a seizure detection device, and  
24 coverage shall be continuous once the seizure detection device  
25 is prescribed.

26 (e) A group or individual policy of accident and health

1 insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered,  
2 issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2028 shall not impose  
3 a deductible, coinsurance, copayment, or any other  
4 cost-sharing requirement of more than \$50 on the coverage of a  
5 seizure detection device per plan year. The provisions of this  
6 subsection do not apply to coverage under this Section to the  
7 extent that the coverage would disqualify a high-deductible  
8 health plan from eligibility for a health savings account.
