

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Climate Displacement Task Force Act is
5 amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

6 (20 ILCS 4138/15)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on December 31, 2028)

8 Sec. 15. Duties. The Climate Displacement Task Force is
9 created to make findings and recommendations regarding climate
10 displacement within this State and to submit 2 reports. The
11 first report shall analyze scientific research and global
12 modeling to accurately assess the level of climate
13 displacement that is projected to happen within the United
14 States and its neighboring countries. The first report shall
15 also delineate the Task Force's findings, conclusions, and
16 recommendations and shall be submitted to the General Assembly
17 no later than December 31 ~~June 30~~, 2026.

18 The second report shall be developed with the information
19 gathered in the first report and shall provide a needs
20 assessment of infrastructure, systems development, and
21 collaboration plans between State agencies to ensure that the
22 State is prepared through 2050 for these upcoming challenges.
23 The second report shall also delineate the Task Force's

1 findings, conclusions, and recommendations and shall be
2 submitted to the General Assembly no later than December 31
3 ~~June 30~~, 2027. In this Section, "systems development" includes
4 building resilient and adaptable systems across various
5 sectors, including governance, infrastructure, and social
6 services, to proactively address the challenges and impacts of
7 climate change-induced displacement.

8 Once the initial voting members have been appointed, the
9 Task Force shall meet not less than once each month following
10 the effective date of this Act to carry out the duties
11 prescribed in this Act.
