1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 3208

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 3208 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by
5 changing Sections 1-130 and 15-312 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 5/1-130) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 1-130)

7 Sec. 1-130. Implement of husbandry. Every vehicle designed
8 and adapted exclusively for agricultural, horticultural, or
9 livestock-raising operations, including farm wagons, wagon
10 trailers, or similar vehicles used in connection with such
11 operations or for lifting or carrying an implement of
12 husbandry that:

13 (1) has only one axle and a gross weight 36,000 pounds
14 or less; or

15 (2) has 2 or more axles and a gross weight of 52,000
16 pounds or less. ~~Every vehicle designed and adapted~~

1 ~~exclusively for agricultural, horticultural, or livestock~~
2 ~~raising operations, including farm wagons, wagon trailers~~
3 ~~or like vehicles used in connection therewith, or for~~
4 ~~lifting or carrying an implement of husbandry provided~~
5 ~~that no farm wagon, wagon trailer or like vehicle having a~~
6 ~~gross weight of more than 36,000 pounds, shall be included~~

10 Sec. 15-312. Fees for police escort. When State Police
11 escorts are required by the Department of Transportation for
12 the safety of the motoring public, the following fees shall be
13 paid by the applicant:

14 (1) to the Department of Transportation: \$40 per hour
15 per vehicle based upon the pre-estimated time of the
16 movement to be agreed upon between the Department and the
17 applicant, with a minimum fee of \$80 per vehicle; and

18 (2) to the Illinois State Police: \$125 ~~\$75~~ per hour
19 per State Police vehicle based upon the actual time of the
20 movement, with a minimum fee of \$500 ~~\$300~~ per State Police
21 vehicle. The Illinois State Police shall remit the moneys
22 to the State Treasurer, who shall deposit the moneys into
23 the State Police Operations Assistance Fund.

24 The actual time of the movement shall be the time the
25 police escort is required to pick up the movement to the time

1 the movement is completed. Any delays or breakdowns shall be
2 considered part of the movement time. Any fraction of an hour
3 shall be rounded up to the next whole hour.

4 The State Police may use an online payment system to
5 accept fees for police escorts.
