SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

305 ILCS 5/5-54 new

Amends the Illinois Public Aid Code. Requires the medical assistance program to provide coverage and reimbursement for a prescribed proteomic blood test to identify and manage the risk of spontaneous preterm birth in pregnant persons. Provides that the test results shall be used to assign care management services and other appropriate interventions to manage risk, prolong pregnancy, and improve outcomes.

4 Section 5. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by
5 adding Section 5-54 as follows:

6 (305 ILCS 5/5-54 new)

7 Sec. 5-54. Coverage for proteomic blood tests.

8 (a) The medical assistance program shall provide coverage
9 and reimbursement for a prescribed proteomic blood test to
10 identify and manage the risk of spontaneous preterm birth in
11 pregnant persons.

12 (b) The test results shall be used to assign care
13 management services and other appropriate interventions to
14 manage risk, prolong pregnancy, and improve outcomes.
