2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 32

8 Illinois Association of Park Districts: After School
9 Programming.

11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
12 the Illinois Route 66 Heritage Project Fund to provide grants
13 for the development of tourism, education, preservation and
14 promotion of Route 66.

15 Section 110. The sum of \$550,000, or so much thereof as may
16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Police Memorial
17 Committee Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
18 grants to the Police Memorial Committee for maintaining a
19 memorial statue, holding an annual memorial commemoration, and
20 giving scholarships or grants to children and spouses of
21 police officers killed in the line of duty.

22 Section 115. The following named sum, or so much thereof

1 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated to the
 2 Office of the Secretary of State for such purposes in Section
 3 3-646 of the Illinois Vehicle Code, for grants to the Regional
 4 Organ Bank of Illinois and to Mid-America Transplant Services
 5 for the purpose of promotion of organ and tissue donation
 6 awareness. These amounts are in addition to any amounts
 7 otherwise appropriated to the Office of the Secretary of
 8 State:

9 From Organ Donor Awareness Fund125,000

10 Section 120. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may
 11 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
 12 the Chicago Police Memorial Foundation Fund for grants to the
 13 Chicago Police Memorial Foundation for maintenance of a
 14 memorial and park, holding an annual memorial commemoration,
 15 giving scholarships to children of police officers killed or
 16 catastrophically injured in the line of duty, providing
 17 financial assistance to police officers and their families
 18 when a police officer is killed or injured in the line of duty,
 19 and paying the insurance premiums for police officers who are
 20 terminally ill.

21 Section 125. The sum of \$145,000, or so much thereof as may
 22 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
 23 the U.S. Marine Corps Scholarship Fund to provide grants per
 24 Section 3-651 of the Illinois Vehicle Code.

1 Section 130. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the SOS Federal
3 Projects Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for the
4 payment of any operational expenses relating to the cost
5 incident to augmenting the Illinois Commercial Motor Vehicle
6 safety program by assuring and verifying the identity of
7 drivers prior to licensure, including CDL operators; for
8 improved security for Drivers Licenses and Personal
9 Identification Cards; and any other related program deemed
10 appropriate by the Office of the Secretary of State.

11 Section 135. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
13 Secretary of State from the Securities Investors Education
14 Fund for any expenses used to promote public awareness of the
15 dangers of securities fraud.

16 Section 140. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
17 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
18 of State from the Secretary of State Evidence Fund for the
19 purchase of evidence, for the employment of persons to obtain
20 evidence, and for the payment for any goods or services
21 related to obtaining evidence.

22 Section 145. The sum of \$225,000, or so much thereof as may

1 be necessary, is appropriated from the Electric Vehicle Rebate
2 Fund to the Office of Secretary of State for the cost of
3 administering the Electric Vehicle Rebate Act.

4 Section 150. The sum of \$200,000,000, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of
6 State Special Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
7 State for electronic data processing, for office automation
8 and technology, and for operating program expenses related to
9 the enforcement of administering laws related to vehicles and
10 transportation.

11 Section 155. The sum of \$20,000,000, or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Motor Vehicle
13 License Plate Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
14 the cost incident to providing new or replacement plates for
15 motor vehicles.

16 Section 160. The sum of \$4,600,000, or so much thereof as
17 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
18 DUI Administration Fund to the Office of Secretary of State
19 for operation of the Department of Administrative Hearings of
20 the Office of Secretary of State and for no other purpose.

21 Section 165. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State

1 Police Services Fund to the Secretary of State for purposes as
2 indicated by the grantor or contractor or, in the case of money
3 bequeathed or granted for no specific purpose, for any purpose
4 as deemed appropriate by the Director of the Secretary of
5 State Department of Police in administering the
6 responsibilities of the Secretary of State Department of
7 Police.

8 Section 170. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated from the Office of the Secretary
10 of State Grant Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
11 be expended in accordance with the terms and conditions upon
12 which such funds were received.

13 Section 175. The sum of \$24,300, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
15 of State from the State Library Fund to increase the
16 collection of books, records, and holdings; to hold public
17 forums; to purchase equipment and resource materials for the
18 State Library; and for the upkeep, repair, and maintenance of
19 the State Library building and grounds.

20 Section 180. The following sum, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
22 of State for any operations, alterations, rehabilitations, new
23 construction, and maintenance of the interior and exterior of

1 the various buildings and facilities under the jurisdiction of
2 the Secretary of State to enhance security measures in the
3 Capitol Complex:

4 From General Revenue Fund 8,000,000

5 Section 185. The sum of \$50,000,000, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State
7 Identification Security and Theft Prevention Fund to the
8 Office of Secretary of State for all costs related to
9 implementing identification security and theft prevention
10 measures.

11 Section 190. The sum of \$10,000,000 or so much thereof as
12 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
13 Secretary of State from the DMV Transformation Fund for the
14 payment of costs related to the issuance of temporary
15 visitor's driver's licenses, and other operational costs,
16 including personnel, facilities, computer programming, and
17 data transmission.

18 Section 195. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof as
19 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Monitoring Device
20 Driving Permit Administration Fee Fund to the Office of the
21 Secretary of State for all Secretary of State costs associated
22 with administering Monitoring Device Driving Permits per
23 Public Act 95-0400.

1 Section 200. The sum of \$300,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated from the Indigent BAIID Fund to
3 the Office of the Secretary of State to reimburse ignition
4 interlock device providers per Public Act 95-0400, including
5 reimbursements submitted in prior years.

6 Section 205. The sum of \$35,000,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
8 Secretary of State from the Vehicle Hijacking and Motor
9 Vehicle Theft Prevention and Insurance Verification Trust Fund
10 for awards, grants, and operational support to implement the
11 Illinois Vehicle Hijacking and Motor Vehicle Theft Prevention
12 and Insurance Verification Act, and for operational expenses
13 of the Office to implement the Act.

14 Section 210. The sum of \$50,000, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
16 the Illinois Professional Golfers Association Junior Golf Fund
17 for grants to the Illinois Professional Golfers Association
18 Foundation to help Association members expose Illinois
19 youngsters to the game of golf.

20 Section 215. The sum of \$170,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
22 the Agriculture in the Classroom Fund for grants to support

1 Agriculture in the Classroom programming for public and
2 private schools within Illinois.

3 Section 220. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
5 the Boy Scout and Girl Scout Fund for grants to the Illinois
6 divisions of the Boy Scouts of America and the Girl Scouts of
7 the U.S.A.

8 Section 225. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
10 the Support Our Troops Fund for grants to Illinois Support Our
11 Troops, Inc. for charitable assistance to the troops and their
12 families in accordance with its Articles of Incorporation.

13 Section 230. The sum of \$4,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
15 of State from the Rotary Club Fund for grants for charitable
16 purposes sponsored by the Rotary Club.

17 Section 235. The sum of \$13,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
19 of State from the Ovarian Cancer Awareness Fund for grants to
20 the National Ovarian Cancer Coalition, Inc. for ovarian cancer
21 research, education, screening, and treatment.

1 Section 240. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as may
2 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
3 of State from the Sheet Metal Workers International
4 Association of Illinois Fund for grants for charitable
5 purposes sponsored by Illinois chapters of the Sheet Metal
6 Workers International Association.

7 Section 245. The sum of \$120,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
9 of State from the Illinois Police Association Fund for
10 providing death benefits for the families of police officers
11 killed in the line of duty, and for providing scholarships,
12 for graduate study, undergraduate study, or both, to children
13 and spouses of police officers killed in the line of duty.

14 Section 250. The sum of \$10,000, or so much thereof as may
15 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
16 the International Brotherhood of Teamsters Fund for grants to
17 the Teamsters Joint Council 25 Charitable Trust for religious,
18 charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes.

19 Section 255. The sum of \$16,000, or so much thereof as may
20 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
21 of State from the Fraternal Order of Police Fund for grants to
22 the Illinois Fraternal Order of Police to increase the
23 efficiency and professionalism of law enforcement officers in

1 Illinois, to educate the public about law enforcement issues,
2 to more firmly establish the public confidence in law
3 enforcement, to create partnerships with the public, and to
4 honor the service of law enforcement officers.

5 Section 260. The sum of \$35,000, or so much thereof as may
6 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
7 the Share the Road Fund for grants to the League of Illinois
8 Bicyclists, a not for profit corporation, for educational
9 programs instructing bicyclists and motorists how to legally
10 and more safely share the roadways.

11 Section 265. The sum of \$25,000, or so much thereof as may
12 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
13 of State from the Ducks Unlimited Fund for grants to Ducks
14 Unlimited, Inc. to fund wetland protection, enhancement, and
15 restoration projects in the State of Illinois, to fund
16 education and outreach for media, volunteers, members, and the
17 general public regarding waterfowl and wetlands conservation
18 in the State of Illinois, and to cover reasonable cost for
19 Ducks Unlimited plate advertising and administration of the
20 wetland conservation projects and education program.

21 Section 270. The sum of \$200,000, or so much thereof as may
22 be necessary, is appropriated to the Secretary of State from
23 the Family Responsibility Fund for all costs associated with

1 enforcement of the Family Financial Responsibility Law.

2 Section 275. The sum of \$450,000, or so much thereof as may
3 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
4 of State from the Illinois State Police Memorial Park Fund for
5 grants to the Illinois State Police Heritage Foundation, Inc.
6 for building and maintaining a memorial and park, holding an
7 annual memorial commemoration, giving scholarships to children
8 of State police officers killed or catastrophically injured in
9 the line of duty, and providing financial assistance to police
10 officers and their families when a police officer is killed or
11 injured in the line of duty.

12 Section 280. The sum of \$6,000, or so much thereof as may
13 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
14 of State from the Illinois Sheriffs' Association Scholarship
15 and Training Fund for grants to the Illinois Sheriffs'
16 Association for scholarships obtained in a competitive process
17 to attend the Illinois Teen Institute or an accredited college
18 or university, for programs designed to benefit the elderly
19 and teens, and for law enforcement training.

20 Section 285. The sum of \$1,200,000, or so much thereof as
21 may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
22 Secretary of State from the Alzheimer's Awareness Fund for
23 grants to the Alzheimer's Disease and Related Disorders

1 Association, Greater Illinois Chapter, for Alzheimer's care,
2 support, education, and awareness programs.

3 Section 290. The sum of \$40,000, or so much thereof as may
4 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
5 of State from the Illinois Nurses Foundation Fund for grants
6 to the Illinois Nurses Foundation, to promote the health of
7 the public by advancing the nursing profession in this State.

8 Section 295. The sum of \$3,000, or so much thereof as may
9 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
10 of State from the Hospice Fund for grants to a statewide
11 organization whose primary membership consists of hospice
12 programs.

13 Section 300. The sum of \$45,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the Secretary
15 of State from the Octave Chanute Aerospace Heritage Fund for
16 grants to the Rantoul Historical Society and Museum, or any
17 other charitable foundation responsible for the former
18 exhibits and collections of the Chanute Air Museum, for
19 operational and program expenses of the Chanute Air Museum and
20 any other structure housing exhibits and collections of the
21 Chanute Air Museum.

22 Section 305. The sum of \$0, or so much thereof as may be

1 necessary, is appropriated from the Secretary of State Special
2 Services Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
3 operating program expenses related to the enforcement of
4 administering laws related to vehicles and transportation.

5 Section 310. The sum of \$2,500,000 or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
7 Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for all Secretary
8 of State costs associated with the implementation of the
9 provisions of Article XIV of the Illinois Constitution,
10 including, without limitation, the duties under the
11 Constitutional Convention Act and the Illinois Constitutional
12 Amendment Act.

13 Section 315. The amount of \$155,000, or so much of this
14 amount as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
15 Revenue Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
16 ordinary and contingent expenses of the Executive Inspector
17 General.

18 Section 320. The amount of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated to the Office of the
20 Secretary of State from the General Revenue Fund for deposit
21 into the Secretary of State Special Services Fund for
22 technology modernization and maintenance of information
23 technology systems and infrastructure and other costs.

1 Section 325. The amount of \$400,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Electronic
3 Notarization Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State to
4 fund the Department of Index's implementation and maintenance
5 of the electronic notarization commissions.

6 Section 330. The amount of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the 100 Club of
8 Illinois Fund to the Office of the Secretary of State for
9 grants and administrative expenses associated with providing
10 resources to families of first responders killed in the line
11 of duty and to active duty first responders.

12 Section 335. The amount of \$0, or so much thereof as may be
13 necessary is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the
14 Office of the Secretary of State for grants, contracts, and
15 administrative expenses associated with Agudath Israel of
16 Illinois for school transportation.

17 Section 340. The amount of \$6,000,000, or so much thereof
18 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the State Facility
19 Repair and Maintenance Fund to the Office of the Secretary of
20 State for repairs, maintenance, and other permanent
21 improvements.

1 Section 345. No contract shall be entered into or
2 obligation incurred or any expenditure made from any
3 appropriation herein made in Section 340 of this Article until
4 after the purpose and amounts have been approved in writing by
5 the Governor.

6 Section 999. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
7 2026.
