WHEREAS, Jason Roscow demonstrated a commitment to service from a young age, volunteering as a firefighter for the Prairie du Rocher Fire Department; after graduating from Red Bud High School, he enlisted in the United States Air Force, where he served in the security police and was stationed in locations worldwide, including South Korea, Iraq, and Kuwait; and

WHEREAS, Jason Roscow continued his dedication to protecting others following his military service by becoming a police officer with the North Las Vegas Police Department, where he served honorably for 17 years; and
