SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, Maintaining proper oral hygiene and preserving natural teeth are essential steps to ensuring optimal oral health, which impacts patients' overall health and well-being; and

WHEREAS, Each year, over 25 million teeth are preserved through endodontic treatments, including 15 million root canal procedures, emphasizing the importance of saving natural teeth for improved appearance and maintaining essential functions such as chewing and speech; and

WHEREAS, Endodontists, as highly skilled dental specialists, excel in diagnosing and treating tooth pain and infection through life-changing endodontic procedures, including root canals, trauma dental injuries, vital pulp therapy, and apicoectomies, that safeguard their patients' natural teeth; with three additional years of training post-dental school, they utilize advanced technology and specialized care to best treat tooth pain and infection; and

WHEREAS, Endodontists dedicate their dental practice exclusively to endodontic treatments, performing an average of 25 root canal treatments weekly; they frequently collaborate with general dentists to ensure comprehensive dental care and

- 16 practice good oral hygiene to save their natural teeth.
