2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened 3 to learn of the death of Craig A. Roberts of Washington, D.C., 4 formerly of Alton, who passed away on February 15, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Craig Roberts, the son of Jack and Rosemary (Pichee) Roberts, was born in Alton on June 17, 1962; he graduated from Alton High School in 1980; he attended Lewis and Clark Community College, received a Bachelor of Science from Western Illinois University in 1984, and continued his education at the University of Illinois Springfield; and

WHEREAS, Craig Roberts began his extensive career in politics as program director of the Illinois House Republican Organization in 1986; he then worked as assistant to the Lieutenant Governor of Illinois and later served as assistant to the secretary of the Illinois Secretary of State for seven years; and

WHEREAS, Craig Roberts then moved to Washington, D.C., where he worked as chief of staff for Congressman John Shimkus from 1997 to 2021; he later served as a special advisor for the House Committee on Administration and then as a consultant, concluding his career as senior vice president at Milne, Wiener & Shofe Global Strategies; and

- 3 staff association in the history of Congress, from 2015 to
- 4 2020; he also served as secretary of the Capitol Hill Club

- 6 WHEREAS, Craig Roberts co-authored several editions of the
- 7 Almanac of Illinois Politics during his time in state
- 8 government; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Craig Roberts was generous and humble,
- demonstrating his kindness to family, friends, and colleagues
- in a myriad of ways, and he will be remembered as a dedicated
- 12 public servant and an invaluable mentor to many; and

- 14 parents; his sister, Sheryl Goodpasture; and his grandparents;
