SENATE RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate wish to congratulate HSHS St. Anthony's Memorial Hospital in Effingham on the occasion of marking 150 years of service; and

WHEREAS, HSHS St. Anthony's Memorial Hospital originated when Sisters Euphemia Gaertner, Fortunata Honkamp, and Franziska Dreisvogt of the Hospital Sisters of St. Francis arrived in Effingham on November 15, 1875, where they began serving the poor and the sick; their efforts led to the opening of St. Anthony's Hospital on September 15, 1877, and the hospital was later renamed St. Anthony's Memorial Hospital in 1954; and

13 WHEREAS, HSHS St. Anthony's Memorial Hospital, an 14 affiliate of the Hospital Sisters Health System (HSHS), is a 15 fully accredited, not-for-profit, general acute care health 16 facility today; and

WHEREAS, HSHS St. Anthony's Memorial Hospital has 133 licensed beds and a workforce of more than 700 employees, and its medical staff represents more than 70 local physician providers in 26 specialties and includes over 80 consulting physicians; and
