WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois Senate are saddened to learn of the death of Nancy M. Hahn of Springfield, who passed away on May 5, 2025; and

WHEREAS, Nancy Hahn, the daughter of Mercedes and Robert McHugh, was born in Cape Girardeau, Missouri on January 25, 1932; she graduated from Ursuline Academy in St. Louis, Missouri; she and her family moved to Springfield in 1951; she attended Webster University in Webster Groves, Missouri and Saint Catherine's College in Saint Paul, Minnesota; she received a Master of Arts from University of Illinois Springfield; she married Carl H. Becker Jr. in 1956, and they had three children and were married for 30 years before their divorce; she later married Ralph C. Hahn; and

WHEREAS, Nancy Hahn was a member of the Springfield Junior League, where she served as a docent at the Illinois State Museum for many years and participated as a guide in all Abraham Lincoln historical events; she was also active in many other organizations, including as a lifetime member of the Lincoln Memorial Garden, a leader of a Land of Lincoln Girl Scout troop, and a member of the University of Illinois Alumni Advisory Board, the University of Illinois Springfield Chancellor's Circle, the Women for Women of Springfield
