4 February 1, 2025; and

7 community; she served as treasurer of the Ping Tom Park
8 Advisory Council and played a key role in organizing community
9 events, including the Back-to-School celebration and
10 Trunk-or-Treat; and

11 WHEREAS, May Chin was actively involved in the Chinese
12 American Civic Council, working to support immigrant
13 communities and promote civic engagement, and she prioritized
14 supporting local organizations, including the Chinese American
15 Museum of Chicago (CAMOC), where she contributed her story to
16 the museum's oral history project; and

17 WHEREAS, May Chin will be remembered for her kindness,
18 dedication, generosity, and her commitment to community
19 service; therefore, be it
