15 and known for his generosity and willingness to lend a helping  
16 hand; he led efforts to improve and maintain the Athens Park as  
17 board president and later served as Menard County Commissioner  
18 for several years, making a lasting impact; and

20 whether taking a trip, tackling a project, or just sharing  
21 laughs, and his grandchildren could always count on him for a
