WHEREAS, Mark Morgan worked a variety of jobs before finding his calling as an electrician; he was hired by the City of Chicago, where he trained and excelled as a lineman, lampman, and a journeyman electrician; after retirement, he continued his work as an independent contractor with the electrician union and founded Faith Electric; and
