## **Order of Resolutions**

H.R. 950 -- Villa - Welch - Pappas - Kalish - Hernandez, Elizabeth --- Urges Congress and the President of the United States to grant the right and privilege of United States residency to all farm, agricultural, and manufacturing workers who have served and labored during the COVID-19 crisis. (Executive RBA)

H.R. 954 -- Stuart - Durkin --- Supports and urges the Governor and the Secretary of the IDFPR to issue an Amended Emergency Proclamation to include an amended version that allows dentists to receive, store, and administer the COVID-19 vaccine and a second provision allowing Just in Time (JIT) training for both dentists and dental hygienists in order to participate in mass vaccination efforts throughout the State of Illinois. (Executive RBA)
