SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 500/30-50 new

Amends the Illinois Procurement Code. Provides that when the Department of Transportation enters into a contract under the Code that provides for mobilization payments and the contractor is using the services of a subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms requiring mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor. Provides for a schedule of mobilization payments based on the initial value of the subcontract. Defines "mobilization payment".

1 AN ACT concerning finance.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by adding Section 30-50 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/30-50 new)
- 7 Sec. 30-50. Mobilization payments.
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "mobilization payment" means
 9 an advance payment for the preparatory work and operations
 10 necessary for the movement of personnel, equipment, supplies,
 11 and incidentals to a project site and for all other work or
 12 operations that must be performed or costs incurred when
- 13 beginning work on a project.
- 14 <u>(b) When a contract under this Code entered into by the</u>
 15 <u>Department of Transportation provides for mobilization</u>
 16 <u>payments and the contractor is using the services of a</u>
 17 <u>subcontractor, the subcontract shall include terms requiring</u>
 18 mobilization payments be made to the subcontractor.
- Mobilization payments to a subcontractor shall be made on a tiered system based on the initial value of the subcontract:
- 21 Subcontract value Mobilization percentage
- 22 <u>Less than \$10,000</u> <u>25%</u>
- 23 \$10,000-\$19,999 20%
