## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 1605/7.18 new

Amends the Illinois Lottery Law. Provides that the name, address, phone number, or other personally identifying information of a recipient of a prize may not be disclosed without the consent of the recipient and shall be exempt from disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act. Provides that the awarding of a prize may not be conditioned upon disclosure of the identity of the recipient.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Illinois Lottery Law is amended by adding Section 7.18 as follows:

7 Sec. 7.18. Disclosure of identity of winners. Department may not disclose to the public the name, address, 8 9 phone number, or other personally identifying information of 10 any recipient of a prize unless the recipient consents in writing to the disclosure. Additionally, the name, address, 11 phone number, or other personally identifying information of 12 any recipient of a prize shall be exempt from disclosure under 13 14 the Freedom of Information Act.
