1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 771

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 771 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
5 adding Section 11-6-9 as follows:

6 (65 ILCS 5/11-6-9 new)

7 Sec. 11-6-9. Purchase of tires under joint purchasing
8 authority.

9 (a) As used in this Section:

10 "Vehicle" has the meaning provided in Section 1-146 of the
11 Illinois Vehicle Code.

12 "Volunteer firefighter" means a firefighter who does not
13 receive monetary compensation for his or her services to a
14 municipal fire department.

15 (b) If authorized by the fire chief of the fire department,
16 any regularly enrolled volunteer firefighter may purchase 4

1 vehicle tires every 3 years through his or her fire
2 department's or municipality's contract to purchase vehicle
3 tires under Section 2 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act.
4 The authorization must be in writing and on the fire
5 department's letterhead, and must include the volunteer
6 firefighter's name, the license plate number of the vehicle for
7 the authorized purchase, and must reference the fire
8 department's or municipality's joint purchasing agreement.

9 (c) The fire department or municipality shall alone be
10 responsible for documenting how many tires each volunteer
11 firefighter purchases during the specified periods under this
12 Section.

13 (d) The firefighter shall pay for any tires, and any
14 related taxes, purchased under this Section.

15 (e) Purchase of tires under this Section are not considered
16 tax exempt.

17 (f) This Section applies to contracts first solicited under
18 Section 4 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act on or after
19 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General
20 Assembly.

21 Section 10. The Fire Protection District Act is amended by
22 adding Section 10d as follows:

23 (70 ILCS 705/10d new)

24 Sec. 10d. Purchase of tires under joint purchasing

1 authority.

2 (a) As used in this Section:

3 "Vehicle" has the meaning provided in Section 1-146 of the
4 Illinois Vehicle Code.

5 "Volunteer firefighter" means a firefighter who does not
6 receive monetary compensation for his or her services to a fire
7 protection district.

8 (b) If authorized by the fire chief of the fire protection
9 district, any regularly enrolled volunteer firefighter may
10 purchase 4 vehicle tires every 3 years through his or her fire
11 protection district's contract to purchase vehicle tires under
12 Section 2 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act. The
13 authorization must be in writing and on the fire protection
14 district's letterhead, and must include the volunteer
15 firefighter's name, the license plate number of the vehicle for
16 the authorized purchase, and must reference the fire protection
17 district's joint purchasing agreement.

18 (c) The fire protection district shall alone be responsible
19 for documenting how many tires each volunteer firefighter
20 purchases during the specified period under this Section.

21 (d) The firefighter shall pay for any tires, and any
22 related taxes, purchased under this Section.

23 (e) Purchase of tires under this Section are not considered
24 tax exempt.

25 (f) This Section applies to contracts first solicited under
26 Section 4 of the Governmental Joint Purchasing Act on or after

1 the effective date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General
2 Assembly.

3 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
4 becoming law.".
