SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

20 ILCS 835/4d new

Amends the State Parks Act. Provides that persons over 65 or persons with disabilities who have been issued a valid decal or license plate by the Secretary of State upon its verification may operate a golf cart on paved roads within the boundaries of a State park and as otherwise authorized by the Department of Natural Resources. Defines "golf cart".

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Parks Act is amended by adding Section 4d as follows:
- 6 (20 ILCS 835/4d new)
- Sec. 4d. Limited use of golf carts in State parks. Persons 7 over 65 or persons with disabilities who have been issued a 8 9 valid decal or license plate by the Secretary of State under Section 3-616 of the Illinois Vehicle Code upon its 10 verification may operate a golf cart on paved roads within the 11 boundaries of a State park and as otherwise authorized by the 12 Department. For the purposes of this Section, "golf cart" as 13 14 the same meaning ascribed to it in Section 1-123.9 of the Illinois Vehicle Code. 15
