SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

220 ILCS 5/5-118 new

Amends the Public Utilities Act. Provides that, on April 1 of each year beginning the year after the effective date of the amendatory Act, privately held public water utilities shall provide annual reports to the Illinois Commerce Commission with specified information for each municipality served by the utility. Provides that the utility shall certify the accuracy of the information provided in the reports. Effective immediately.

 - (1) the information included in Standard Appendix A in the Statement of Operating Income with Adjustments;
- 15 (2) the actual cost of capital improvement projects
 16 completed during the reporting year;
- 17 (3) planned capital improvements for each of the coming
 18 5 reporting years;
- 19 <u>(4) usage and revenue data by customer class within the</u>
 20 municipality;
- 21 <u>(5) any available and applicable water quality</u>
 22 reports;
- 23 (6) reports of any major water leaks;

1	(7) a summary of water loss in the water distribution
2	system for the reporting year;
3	(8) a list of boil orders;
4	(9) a report on water sources divided by surface water
5	and ground water;
6	(10) a summary of revenue and cost information that
7	indicates how common costs to the privately held public
8	water utility are allocated across communities; and
9	(11) techniques and practices for allocated costs.
10	The privately held water utility shall provide a report
11	containing this information for each municipality served by the

13	certify the accuracy of the information provided under this
