### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/3.4b new

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that unless otherwise permitted by law, no person may have in their possession a weapon except those specified by the Code or administrative rules for the purpose of taking any species protected by the Code. Provides that any use of a weapon to take wildlife contrary to the provisions of the Code is deemed a violation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by adding Section  
5 3.4b as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/3.4b new)

7 Sec. 3.4b. Authorized weapons. Unless otherwise permitted  
8 by law, no person may have in their possession a weapon except  
9 those specified by this Code or administrative rules for the  
10 purpose of taking any species protected by this Code. Any use  
11 of a weapon to take wildlife contrary to the provisions of this  
12 Code is deemed a violation of this Code.
