## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Amends Public Act 100-21. Removes references to evidencebased funding and instead inserts references to general State aid. Repeals provisions for funding bilingual education and transitions to evidence-based funding. Makes changes to various line items. Adds line items for disabled student personnel reimbursement, extraordinary funding for children requiring special education, summer school payments, and bilingual education. Makes other changes. Effective immediately.
