SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/10-20.67 new
105 ILCS 5/34-18.60 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that a school board shall require its schools to connect at-risk students in need of behavioral health support and all students with an individualized education program to either community-based or in-school behavioral health support. If the school board requires in-school support to be provided, such support does not have to be implemented until the beginning of the 2018-2019 school year. Effective immediately.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
5 10-20.67 and 34-18.60 as follows:

6 (105 ILCS 5/10-20.67 new)

7 Sec. 10-20.67. Behavioral health support. A school board
8 shall require its schools to connect at-risk students in need
9 of behavioral health support and all students with an
10 individualized education program to either community-based or
11 in-school behavioral health support. If the school board
12 requires in-school support to be provided, such support does
13 not have to be implemented until the beginning of the 2018-2019
14 school year.

16 Sec. 34-18.60. Behavioral health support. The board shall
17 require its schools to connect at-risk students in need of
18 behavioral health support and all students with an
19 individualized education program to either community-based or
20 in-school behavioral health support. If the board requires
21 in-school support to be provided, such support does not have to
22 be implemented until the beginning of the 2018-2019 school

1 year.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
3 becoming law.
