1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4416

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4416 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Transportation Network Providers Act is
5 amended by changing Section 15 as follows:

6 (625 ILCS 57/15)

7 (Section scheduled to be repealed on June 1, 2020)

8 Sec. 15. Driver requirements.

9 (a) Prior to permitting an individual to act as a TNC
10 driver on its digital platform, the TNC shall:

11 (1) require the individual to submit an application to
12 the TNC or a third party on behalf of the TNC, which
13 includes information regarding his or her full legal name,
14 social security number, address, age, date of birth,
15 driver's license, driving history, motor vehicle
16 registration, automobile liability insurance, and other

1 information required by the TNC;

2 (2) conduct, or have a third party conduct, a local and
3 national criminal history background check for each
4 individual applicant that shall include:

5 (A) Multi-State or Multi-Jurisdictional Criminal
6 Records Locator or other similar commercial nationwide
7 database with validation (primary source search); and

8 (B) National Sex Offenders Registry database; and

9 (3) obtain and review a driving history research report
10 for the individual.

11 (b) The TNC shall not permit an individual to act as a TNC
12 driver on its digital platform who:

13 (1) has had more than 3 moving violations in the prior
14 three-year period, or one major violation in the prior
15 three-year period including, but not limited to,
16 attempting to evade the police, reckless driving, or
17 driving on a suspended or revoked license;

18 (2) has been convicted, within the past 7 years, of
19 driving under the influence of drugs or alcohol, fraud,
20 sexual offenses, use of a motor vehicle to commit a felony,
21 a crime involving property damage, or theft, acts of
22 violence, or acts of terror;

23 (3) is a match in the National Sex Offenders Registry
24 database;

25 (4) does not possess a valid driver's license;

26 (5) does not possess proof of registration for the

1 motor vehicle used to provide TNC services;

2 (6) does not possess proof of automobile liability
3 insurance for the motor vehicle used to provide TNC
4 services; or

5 (7) is under 19 years of age.

6 (c) An individual who submits an application under
7 paragraph (1) of subsection (a) that contains false or
8 incomplete information shall be guilty of a petty offense.

9 (d) A TNC that reasonably relies on the information
10 provided by an individual under this Section shall not be
11 liable for a violation of this Section.
