SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

745 ILCS 49/66 new

Amends the Good Samaritan Act. Provides that a person who in good faith and without fee administers epinephrine to another person who is suffering from a severe allergic reaction shall not be liable for civil damages as a result of his or her acts or omissions, except for willful or wanton misconduct on the part of the person in administering the epinephrine.

4 Section 5. The Good Samaritan Act is amended by adding
5 Section 66 as follows:

7 Sec. 66. Epinephrine administration. A person who in good
8 faith and without fee administers epinephrine to another person
9 who is suffering from a severe allergic reaction shall not be
10 liable for civil damages as a result of his or her acts or
11 omissions, except for willful or wanton misconduct on the part
12 of the person in administering the epinephrine.
