1 AN ACT concerning government.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Sections 13 and 195 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/13 new)
- Sec. 13. Monarch Month. The month of May of each year is
- 8 <u>designated as Monarch Month to be observed throughout the State</u>
- 9 as a month to honor the Monarch Butterfly, which is the
- official State insect of the State of Illinois.
- 11 (5 ILCS 490/195 new)
- 12 Sec. 195. Day of the Horse. The fifth day of March of each
- 13 year shall be designated as the Day of the Horse, to be
- 14 <u>observed throughout the State as a day to encourage citizens to</u>
- 15 honor and celebrate the role of equines in the history and
- 16 character of Illinois, and to recognize the benefits of the
- 17 equine industry to the economy, agriculture, tourism, and
- quality of life in Illinois.
- 19 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 20 becoming law.
