1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 4747

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend House Bill 4747 on page 4, by
3 inserting immediately below line 8 the following:

4 "Nonroad engine" means an internal combustion engine,
5 including the fuel system, that is not (i) used in a motor
6 vehicle or a vehicle used solely for competition or (ii)
7 subject to the standards of performance for new stationary
8 sources or the emission standards for new motor vehicles or new
9 motor vehicle engines promulgated under the Clean Air Act, 42
10 U.S.C. 7411 and 7521.

11 "Nonroad equipment" means equipment that is powered by a
12 nonroad engine and that is not a motor vehicle, a vehicle used
13 solely for competition, or a nonroad vehicle.

14 "Nonroad vehicle" means a vehicle that is powered by a
15 nonroad engine and that is not a motor vehicle or a vehicle
16 used solely for competition.

17 "Nonroad engine, nonroad equipment, or nonroad vehicle

1 dealer" means any person who is engaged in the sale or the
2 distribution of new nonroad engines, new nonroad equipment, or
3 new nonroad vehicles to the ultimate purchaser.

4 "Nonroad engine, nonroad equipment, or nonroad vehicle
5 manufacturer" means any person engaged in the manufacturing or
6 assembling of new nonroad engines, new nonroad equipment, or
7 new nonroad vehicles, or importing such engines, equipment, or
8 vehicles for resale, or who acts for and is under the control
9 of any such person in connection with the distribution of new
10 nonroad engines, new nonroad equipment, or new nonroad
11 vehicles, but does not include any dealer with respect to new
12 nonroad engines, new nonroad equipment, or new nonroad vehicles
13 received by the dealer in commerce."; and

14 on page 4, by inserting immediately below line 21 the
15 following:

16 ""Stationary engine" means an internal combustion engine
17 that is not used in a motor vehicle, a vehicle used solely for
18 competition, a nonroad vehicle, or nonroad equipment.

19 "Stationary equipment" means equipment that is powered by a
20 stationary engine and that is not a motor vehicle, a vehicle
21 used solely for competition, a nonroad vehicle, or nonroad
22 equipment.

23 "Stationary engine or stationary equipment dealer" means
24 any person who is engaged in the sale or the distribution of
25 new stationary engines or new stationary equipment to the

1 ultimate purchaser.

2 "Stationary engine or stationary equipment manufacturer"
3 means any person engaged in the manufacturing or assembling of
4 new stationary engines or new stationary equipment, or
5 importing such engines or equipment for resale, or who acts for
6 and is under the control of any such person in connection with
7 the distribution of new stationary engines or new stationary
8 equipment, but does not include any dealer with respect to new
9 stationary engines or new stationary equipment received by the
10 dealer in commerce."; and

11 on page 11, line 2, by inserting after the period the
12 following:

13 "Nothing in this Act applies to (1) nonroad engine, nonroad
14 equipment, or nonroad vehicle manufacturers, any product or
15 service of a nonroad engine, nonroad equipment, or nonroad
16 vehicle manufacturer, or nonroad engine, nonroad equipment, or
17 nonroad vehicle dealers; or (2) stationary engine or stationary
18 equipment manufacturers, any product or service of a stationary
19 engine or stationary equipment manufacturer, or stationary
20 engine or stationary equipment dealers.".
