SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

105 ILCS 5/27-3.10 new

Amends the School Code. Provides that every public elementary school shall include in its 6th, 7th, and 8th grade curriculum, beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, at least one semester of civics education. Sets forth requirements for the course content. Allows school districts to utilize private funding available for the purposes of offering civics education. Effective July 1, 2018.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

STATE MANDATES ACT MAY REQUIRE REIMBURSEMENT 1 AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 5 27-3.10 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/27-3.10 new)
- 7 Sec. 27-3.10. Elementary school civics course of study. In addition to the instruction required to be provided under 8 9 Section 27-3 of this Code, every public elementary school shall include in its 6th, 7th, or 8th grade curriculum, beginning 10 with the 2018-2019 school year, at least one semester of civics 11 education, which shall help young people acquire and learn to 12 use the skills, knowledge, and attitudes that will prepare them 13 14 to be competent and responsible citizens throughout their lives. Civics education course content shall focus on 15 government institutions, the discussion of current and 16 societal issues, service learning, and simulations of the 17 democratic process. Civics education in 6th, 7th, or 8th grade 18 19 shall be in accordance with Illinois Learning Standards for social science. Additionally, school districts may consult 20 21 with civics education stakeholders, deemed appropriate by the 22 State Board of Education, in regard to civics education curriculum for 6th, 7th, or 8th grade. School districts may 2.3
