SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Appropriates \$10,000,000 to the Illinois State Board of Education for after-school art programs and \$10,000,000 to the Illinois Arts Council for community art programs. Effective July 1, 2018.

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois State Board of Education to provide grants for after-school, art-based programs for schools with a low-income pupil count greater than 70% as certified by the Department of Human Services.

Section 10. The sum of \$10,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Illinois Arts Council for community art programs located in a census tract that is 125% below the poverty level according to the United States Census Bureau to administer arts education and art therapy programs.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2018.
