SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-13 new

Amends the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act of the Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that new redevelopment project areas may not be established under the Act until 2 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act. Repeals the provisions 2 years after the effective date of the amendatory Act. Effective immediately.

- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 11-74.4-13 as follows:

- 7 <u>Sec. 11-74.4-13. Two-year moratorium on new redevelopment</u>
- 8 project areas.
- 9 (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, new
- 10 redevelopment project areas may not be established under this
- 11 Act until 2 years after the effective date of this amendatory
- 12 Act of the 100th General Assembly.
- 13 (b) This Section is repealed 2 years after the effective
- 14 date of this amendatory Act of the 100th General Assembly.
- 15 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon
- 16 becoming law.
