2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to recognize the 100th memorial 4 commemoration of the Showmen's League of America's Showmen's 5 Rest at Woodlawn Cemetery in Forest Park; and

6 WHEREAS, The Showmen's League of America (SLA) was founded 7 in 1913 by a group of outdoor showmen meeting at the Saratoga 8 Hotel in Chicago; Buffalo Bill Cody, the Wild West performer, 9 was elected the club's first president; the SLA is the oldest 10 organization of its type in North America; and

WHEREAS, The SLA is a community of showpeople, both men and women, who are dedicated to service and fellowship; by providing scholarships, financial aid, and memorial services, they promote the mutual welfare of their members and all showpeople, in good times and bad; and

WHEREAS, The Showmen's Rest symbolizes the devotion the SLA's has to its members and to showpeople; set in Woodlawn Cemetery, surrounded by five elephants, trunks lowered in mourning, it remains the final resting place for many its members; therefore, be it
