6 speech, interview, personality, and photogenic; she won the MU
7 Award for Academic Distinction in 2018, which recognized her
8 for her intellectual curiosity, her significant contributions
9 to the academic atmosphere, and her ability to seek knowledge
10 outside of the classroom; and

11 WHEREAS, Haley Linder has volunteered with Freedom Wind
12 Farm, where she helped with the care of rehabilitated and
13 retired horses, the Kendall Road Equine Hospital, where she
14 cared for inpatient and outpatient horses, the D and D Farm
15 Animal Sanctuary, where she worked with exotic animals, Cedar
16 Creek Therapeutic Riding Center, where she worked with horses,
17 and the Raptor Rehabilitation Program, where she fed and cared
18 for resident birds; and

20 membership in the University of Missouri Pre-Vet Club, the
21 Kappa Delta Sorority, the University of Missouri Dairy Club,
