1	AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 322
2	AMENDMENT NO Amend Senate Bill 322 on page 64,
3	immediately below line 22, by inserting the following:
4	"(sss) Notwithstanding any provision in this Section to the
5	contrary, nothing in this Section shall prohibit the issuance
6	or renewal of a license authorizing the sale of alcoholic
7	liquor at a store that is located within a municipality with a
8	population in excess of 1,000,000 inhabitants and within 100
9	<pre>feet of a church if:</pre>
10	(1) the premises are primarily used for the sale of
11	alcoholic liquor;
12	(2) on January 1, 2017, the store was authorized to
13	sell alcoholic liquor pursuant to a package goods liquor
14	license;
15	(3) on January 1, 2017, the store occupied
16	approximately 5,560 square feet and will be expanded to
17	include 440 additional square feet for the purpose of
18	storage;

1	(4) the store was in existence before the church;
2	(5) the building in which the store is located was
3	built in 1956 and is immediately south of the church;
4	(6) the store and church are separated by an east-west
5	street;
6	(7) the owner of the store received his first liquor
7	license in 1986;
8	(8) the church has not indicated its opposition to the
9	issuance or renewal of the license in writing; and
10	(9) the alderman of the ward in which the store is
11	located has expressed his or her support for the issuance
12	or renewal of the license.".
