SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

330 ILCS 110/1.1

from Ch. 21, par. 59a1

Amends the Veterans Burial Places Act. Provides that when a headstone or memorial marker is provided for a United States War Veteran pursuant to specified federal law by the federal government, the Department of Veterans' Affairs shall pay an amount not to exceed \$300 (currently, \$100) to the next of kin or cemetery official responsible for the cost of transporting and erecting the headstone or memorial. Effective immediately.

FISCAL NOTE ACT MAY APPLY

1 AN ACT concerning military service.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Veterans Burial Places Act is amended by changing Section 1.1 as follows:
- 6 (330 ILCS 110/1.1) (from Ch. 21, par. 59a1)
- Sec. 1.1. When a headstone or memorial marker is provided for a United States War Veteran by the United States Government 8 9 pursuant to Section 2306 of Title 38 of the United States Code, the Department of Veterans' Affairs shall pay an amount not to 10 exceed \$300 \$100 to the next of kin or cemetery official 11 responsible for the cost of transporting and erecting the 12 13 headstone or memorial. However, no such payment shall be made 14 unless a signed application is presented to the Department by the next of kin or cemetery official, along with such other 15 16 proof of transportation or erection charges as the Department 17 may require. All such applications for payment shall be on forms provided by the Department. 18
