2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Illinois Vehicle Code is amended by changing
Section 4-102 as follows:

(625 ILCS 5/4-102) (from Ch. 95 1/2, par. 4-102) 6 7 Sec. 4-102. Offenses relating to motor vehicles and and other vehicles - Misdemeanors. 8 9 (a) It is a violation of this Chapter for: (1) A person, without authority to do so, to damage a 10 11 vehicle or to damage or remove any part of a vehicle; (2) A person, without authority to do so, to tamper 12 13 with a vehicle or go in it, on it, or work or attempt to 14 work any of its parts, or set or attempt to set it in motion: 15 (3) A person to fail to report a vehicle as unclaimed 16 in accordance with the provisions of Section 4-107. 17 (b) Sentence. A person convicted of a violation of this 18 19 Section shall be guilty of a Class A misdemeanor. A person convicted of a violation of this Section a second or subsequent 20 21 time, shall be guilty of a Class 4 felony.
