SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

325 ILCS 5/4.03 new

Amends the Abused and Neglected Child Reporting Act. Provides that any person required to report under the Act shall complete no less than 4 hours of training every year to recognize signs of domestic violence against minors and non-minors. Provides that training may be conducted by any local domestic violence shelter, hospital, or other domestic violence advocacy group.

4 Section 5. The Abused and Neglected Child Reporting Act is
5 amended by adding Section 4.03 as follows:

7 Sec. 4.03. Domestic violence training. Any person required
8 to report under this Act shall complete no less than 4 hours of
9 training every year to recognize signs of domestic violence
10 against minors and non-minors. Training may be conducted by any
11 local domestic violence shelter, hospital, or other domestic
12 violence advocacy group.
