## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

520 ILCS 5/2.5

Amends the Wildlife Code. Provides that any person may use a crossbow to take any animal during the appropriate archery season. Effective immediately.

# Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

Section 5. The Wildlife Code is amended by changing Section
2.5 as follows:

6 (520 ILCS 5/2.5)

7 Sec. 2.5. Crossbow conditions.

8 <u>(a)</u> A person may use a crossbow if one or more of the 9 following conditions are met:

10

(1) the user is a person age 62 and older;

(2) the user is a person with a disability to whom the Director has issued a permit to use a crossbow, as provided by administrative rule; or

(3) the date of using the crossbow is during the period
of the second Monday following the Thanksgiving holiday
through the last day of the archery deer hunting season
(both inclusive) set annually by the Director.

18 (b) As used in this Section, "person with a disability" 19 means a person who has a physical impairment due to injury or 20 disease, congenital or acquired, which renders the person so 21 severely disabled as to be unable to use a longbow, recurve 22 bow, or compound bow.
